

Welcome Third Graders!

The first day of school is Monday, August 23 at 8:00 am. Third grade will be meeting in classroom #4. Below is a list of items your child should bring on the first day of school:

- ❑ Pencil box
- ❑ 1 box of pencils (No mechanical pencils)
- ❑ a small box of colored pencils
- ❑ 1 or 2 glue sticks
- ❑ a pair of scissors
- ❑ a ruler with inches and centimeters
- ❑ 2 packages **College**-Ruled lined paper (and be sure to have a supply at home)
- ❑ 1 spiral notebook: **5** subject, **College**-Ruled (do not get wide-ruled)
- ❑ 2 pocket folders (one for seatwork and the other for homework)
- ❑ 2 rolls of paper towels
- ❑ 1 boxes of facial tissue

With the exception of the lined paper, tissues, wipes, and paper towels, all supplies need to be **labeled** with your child's name. Due to space limitations, backpacks are **not** allowed. However, a tote style bag is permitted so long as it can be folded neatly to fit into your child's cubby. Please be sure your child brings a snack and lunch from home starting the first week of school.

I encourage your child to read lots of books and practice different math facts for addition, subtraction, and multiplication through the Fives over the summer. It is also important that your child plays outside and enjoys relaxing activities during vacation! Have a great rest of the summer and I'll see you soon!
