## STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES

At Carden School of Fresno, we do not believe that national testing shows the full scope of a student's abilities. It is, however, a fair measure of improvement and overall performance. CSOF administers the Stanford Achievement Test Series, Tenth Edition (SAT 10) for student performance assessment.

A summary of student averages for the 2017-2018 academic year is listed below.

First Grade: The average CSOF first grade student performed at a 2.3 (second

grade, third month) grade equivalent and in the 67<sup>th</sup>

percentile (national average).

Second Grade: Students averaged a 3.5 grade equivalency and in the 67<sup>th</sup>

percentile.

Third Grade: The student average was a grade equivalent of 6.8 with

performance in the 84<sup>th</sup> percentile.

Fourth Grade: Average student performance was in the 80<sup>th</sup> percentile with a

grade equivalency of 7.3.

Fifth Grade: The average student scored in the 76<sup>th</sup> percentile and at a 7.2

grade equivalency.

Sixth Grade: These students averaged in the 79<sup>th</sup> percentile with a grade

equivalency of 12.9.

Seventh Grade: The average grade equivalent was 11.2 and students performed

in the 74<sup>th</sup> percentile.

Eighth Grade: Our eighth graders scored at the 12.2 grade equivalency and in

the 87<sup>th</sup> percentile.

The overall average percentile ranking for the CSOF students tested in the 2017-2018 academic year is 79. On average, our students scored at 2.5 grade levels above the national average.
